Maintain your drains

Over time, the drains in your sinks begin to build up with gunk. If you wait for them to plug up, then you have to clear them using aggressive chemicals. Instead, we recommend that you treat your drains with baking soda. Just run the water in the tap until it's very hot, then sprinkle baking soda down the drain and continue to flush with very hot water. This will remove the gunk that builds up in your drainpipes, and will keep them clear and smelling nice. (Article from Home

DIY Tip: When storing a paintbrush overnight in mineral spirits or water, attach a thin stick, slightly longer than the brush, to the handle with a rubber band. You'll keep the bristles from curling and also prevent the brush from sitting in any paint debris that settles to the bottom of the can.
